Based in the Wilderness Youth & Community Centre & St. Oliver's Complex, Elm Park, the Clonmel Community Youth Project engages young people aged between 10 and 24 years in youth work opportunities. The youth worker identifies the needs and interests of young people and responds through the development of tailored and varied youth work responses.

Key responsibilities will include:

- Developing programmes and responses with young people aged 10 to 24 years in evenings and after school hours and including at weekends
