To inspire, support and develop youth information and counselling in Europe and beyond.

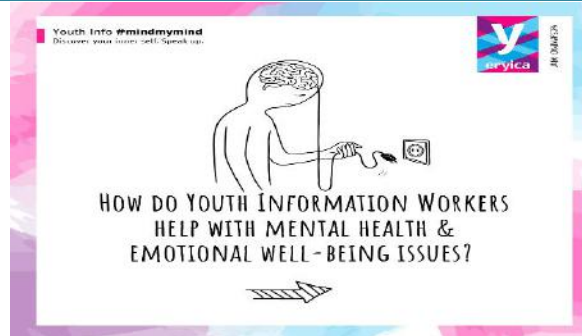
VALUES
